# 2023 Municipal Election Dates and Deadlines

Election Date or Deadline

Oct. 6, 2023: County Boards of Elections begin mailing absentee ballots for November municipal elections to eligible voters who submitted an absentee ballot request.

Oct. 13, 2023: Civilian voter registration deadline for November municipal elections

Oct. 19, 2023: One-stop, in-person early voting begins for November municipal elections.

Oct. 31, 2023: Civilian absentee ballot request deadline for November municipal elections (5 p.m.) Nov. 4, 2023: One-stop, in-person early voting ends for November municipal elections.

Nov. 7, 2023: Election Day in municipalities with November elections

Nov. 7, 2023: Civilian absentee ballot return deadline for November municipal elections (5 p.m.)

Please take some time to get familiar with new changes to voter ID rules and prepare to help voters get an ID prior to election season. We will have more information at our next meeting but this is a good place to start.
