Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 AM, with Chair Hawley welcoming participants. Second Vice Chair Ann Barnes presented Inspirational Thoughts and led in a Moment of Silence. George Revis then led the Pledge of Allegiance. With no objection, the proposed Agenda for today's meeting was approved. The minutes (previously distributed) from our last meeting on June 23, 2022, were approved by consensus.

Party Officers gave brief reports, with Second Vice-Chair Ann Barnes giving an update on the Supreme Court decision to overturn Roe vs. Wade, emphasizing the pervasive impact of the decision.

Reports from the auxiliaries included updates on the Democratic Women of Wilson County by Beth Punte, Co-President.

Precincts reported on a variety of activities such as phone banking, canvassing, voter registration, writing postcards, and sending out informational materials. Several precincts, led by Jackie Williams, Chair of Precinct N, had planned cluster meetings to work together on planning and organizing GOTV efforts.

Lori Oxendine, Chair of Precinct E and designer/manager of our Wilson County Democratic Party website (www.WilsonNCDems.com) then gave a presentation on the features and information available on the website. This deep dive into the WilsonDems website included demonstrations and explanations of features available, with hints on navigation and ways to find information needed, right on our website.

The meeting concluded with announcements of upcoming events, including the upcoming live training on NGP-MINIVAN to be held at the Party Headquarters at 2305 Wellington Drive on July 18. Other announcements included plans for Days of Action with the Team Representative Linda Cooper-Suggs campaign, as Wilson County Democrats continue to learn, experience, and use the new technology of reaching out to our voters.
